The Goal of a C3IFT:

"The primary focus of the **Class 3 Interfacility Transport** or "**C3IFT**" as defined and developed by the WV Office of EMS is to provide field Paramedics with an "extended scope of practice" and is a level of care intended for the transport of patients whose acuity or criticality does not require the level of expertise possessed by the CCT-level provider but exceeds the normal scope of practice for field EMS providers. The paramedic completing this training will prepare him/her to deal with medications and procedures not normally seen during their day-to-day provision of EMS.

Program Outcomes:

Upon successful completion of the C3IFT Education Program, the student will be able to:

1. Sit for the West Virginia C3IFT Certification Exam.
2. Identify the main types of interfacility transports that the EMS system may be called to conduct.
3. Be familiar with the drugs and procedures used within the WVOEMS based C3IFT system.
4. Demonstrate the proper procedures and techniques to deliver medications and manage medication delivery devices safely and appropriately.
5. Implement treatment plans designed by the sending facility for continued continuity of patient care for a wide variety of complaints and age groups involving (but not limited to) respiratory, cardiac, and specialty medical care devices.

Admission Requirements:

Applicants wishing to register for the C3IFT Education Program:

1. Submit an application to Princeton Rescue Squad's Educational Department.

C3IFT Program Costs:

Paid Directly to Princeton Rescue Squad for Program Participation: \$20.00

- The \$20.00 dollars covers the cost of the following:
 - Student tuition \$15.00
 - Registration fee \$5.00



Grounds for Dismissal:

A student may be dismissed from the program for the following reasons:

- Receiving a “D” or “F” as a cumulative grade for the course.
- Inability to complete the online component within the stipulated 4-week window.
- Failure to pass the skill station testing without criteria deficiencies.

Cancellation and Refund Policies:

Payment of course fees is due with receipt of the application. Any student that does not log into the online classroom during the specified 4 week window or chooses to cancel their enrollment agreement prior to logging into the online class will be treated as a cancellation and a full refund will be issued to the student within 45 calendar days of the first scheduled day of class or the date of cancellation, whichever comes first. Also, a full refund will be issued if an applicant is rejected prior to the start date/time of the course, or the program is cancelled by the Squad. A student is classified as a “withdrawal” if he/she logs into the online classroom at least once, but does not complete the program. Any student that withdrawals or is dismissed will not be issued a refund.
