PARAMEDIC COURSE TUITION WAIVER PROGRAM

If you are an employee of Princeton Rescue Squad and interested in obtaining certification as a Paramedic, you may apply for the Princeton Rescue Squad: Paramedic Course Tuition Waiver Program.

STEPS TO BE CONSIDERED:

- Submit a typed essay to the Training Department that contains the following key points:
 - Why is EMS your chosen career path?
 - Why do you want to be a Paramedic?
 - Please provide the committee with a story that details your personal reasons/reflections for pursuing this field.
 - What do you, as an individual, bring to Princeton Rescue Squad?
 - What are your long-term goals?

All submissions received will be anonymously provided to members of the Selection Committee for review. The individual(s) who score highest based on the criteria listed below will be provided with an opportunity to collect a tuition waiver of up to: \$4000.00.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

- Ideas
- Organization
- Topic Points included and Transitions
- Description
- Voice
- Word Choice
- Grammar Usage and Sentence Fluency
- Spelling and Punctuation

TUITION WAIVER AGREEMENT

This Agreement made between the Princeton Rescue Squad Inc, of Princeton, State of West Virginia, herein referred to as "Employer", and _____ herein referred to as "Employee".

The Employer agrees to the following conditions:

1. To provide the Employee a sum of money in the amount of \$ 400.00 for the purpose of purchasing Paramedic Program textbooks.
2. If the Employee passes the 2nd semester term with at least a grade of a "C" for each course enrolled, then the Employer will provide employee a sum of money in the amount of \$1800.00 for the purpose of 3rd semester tuition.
3. If the Employee passes the 3rd semester term with at least a grade of a "C" for each course enrolled, then the Employer will provide the employee a sum of money in the amount of \$1800.00 for the purpose of 4th semester tuition.

Employee agrees to the following conditions:

1. Maintain a grade of at least a "C" for each course enrolled in throughout the Paramedic Program.
2. Obtain National Registry – Paramedic certification after completion of the current course within the allotted time frame of 2 years from the course completion date.
3. Maintain Full-time employment as a Paramedic for a period of 2 years with Princeton Rescue Squad and agree to not work for competing agencies.

If the Employee fails the uphold the terms of the agreement, the employee shall reimburse to the Employer the total amount dispersed to said Employee. In the event that an "Incomplete" is issued for a course in lieu of a letter grade, the Employee will have the choice to either reimburse the Employer for the total amount previously dispersed OR pay for any remaining semester tuition without Employer assistance. Failure to provide Paramedic service for the specified time frame agreed upon whether self or employer terminated will be handled accordingly,

Full reimbursement of the course cost \$ 4000.00 to be withheld from pay or final pay.

After 24 months service at Princeton Rescue Squad as a Paramedic, the employee has no other obligation to this contract and shall be considered satisfied.
